So, what's this show all about?

It includes some of my most favorite images...from some of my most favorite places.

While having a nice “smattering” of images from New York and California, most are from the southwest which draws me back over and over. It is something about the history, the High Desert, the light, the amazing geology, the colors, the Native American (Indians) ruins and Rock Art...I could go on and on, but the images you see will tell the story.

While, the five National Parks in Utah are highlighted, many photos were taken in remote sites, away from the crowds, rarely with anyone else in sight, searching for those elusive paintings (Pictographs) and rock carvings (Petroglyphs), most many hundreds and some, many thousands of years old and somehow still surviving. Fantastic ruins in Colorado (Mesa Verde) and in New Mexico (Aztec Ruins) are shown in some detail. There's also an old railroad town (Chama), contemporary images of a major Balloon Festival (Albuquerque) and of the Air Force Academy (Colorado Springs)...and a lot more.

There are about 400 images including many title slides, and runs about 40 minutes without commentary.
